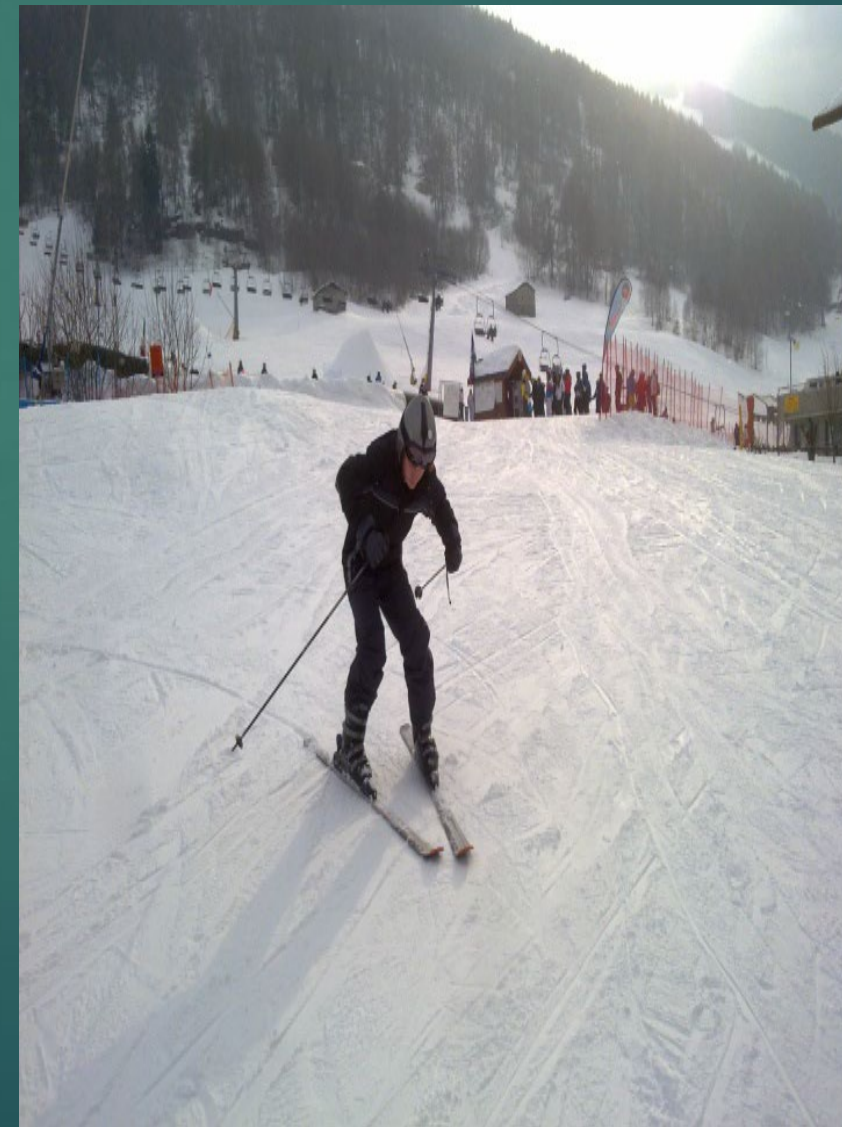

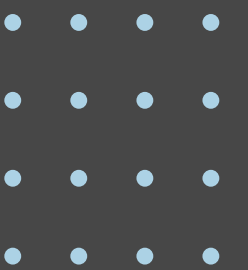

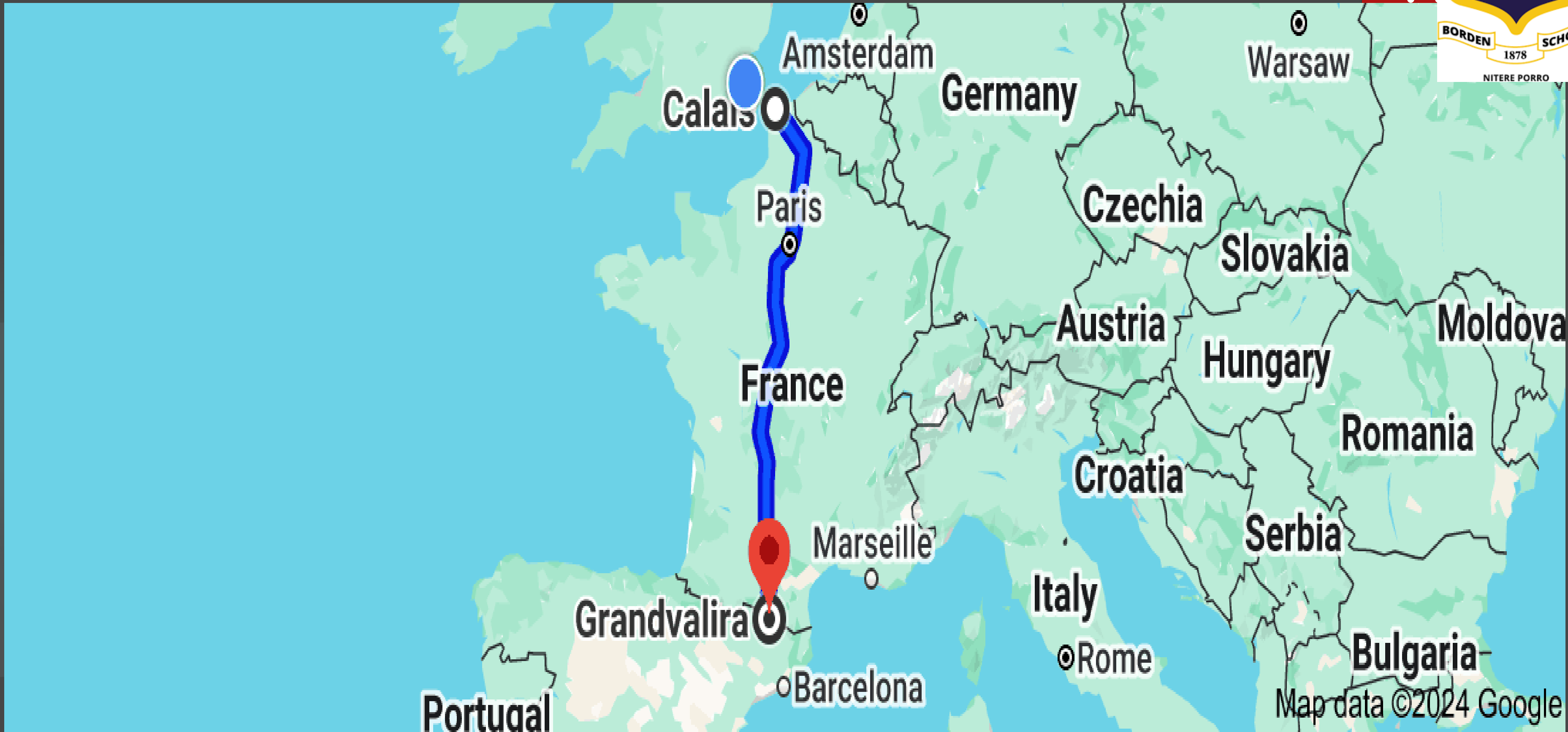

6 days skiing with 5 hours of ski tuition each day – Morning lessons, break for lunch, afternoon lessons.



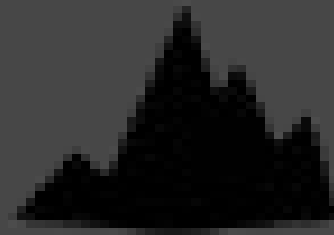
