ACADEMIC YEAR 2022-2023

Tuesday, 1st March 2022 the offer of a secondary school place will be given.

If you named Borden Grammar School as one of your preferences on the SCAF but have not been offered a place at the school, then you have a statutory right of appeal.

If you wish to appeal for a place please complete and return the appeal form on our website directly to us no later than Monday, 28th March 2022 marked for the attention of: Clerk to the Trustees, Borden Grammar School, Avenue of Remembrance, Sittingbourne, Kent ME10 4DB or email to: jcole@bordengrammar.kent.sch.uk. In the first instance, you can complete the form only, stating the reason why you are appealing to Borden Grammar, together with your son's test scores. You can send further supporting evidence at a later date. As soon as your form is received, an information pack will be sent to you with guidance on how to appeal.

Appeals lodged after the appeals deadline of 28th March will be heard within 30 days of submitting the request.

If you did not name Borden Grammar on your application to KCC, you should submit your appeal directly to us after Tuesday, 26th April 2022.

In accordance with Coronavirus guidance, Borden Grammar School appeals in 2022 will be heard in your absence based upon the written evidence you provide. Appeals are scheduled to take place week commencing 25th April 2022. Decision letters will be sent after all appeals have been heard.
