

YEAR 7 APPEALS

ACADEMIC YEAR 2023-2024

Wednesday, 1st March 2023 the offer of a secondary school place will be given.

If you named Borden Grammar School as one of your preferences on the SCAF but have not been offered a place at the school, then you have a statutory right of appeal.

If you wish to appeal for a place please complete and return the appeal form on our website directly to us no later than Tuesday, 28th March 2023 marked for the attention of: Clerk to the Trustees, Borden Grammar School, Avenue of Remembrance, Sittingbourne, Kent ME10 4DB or email it to: jcole@bordengrammar.kent.sch.uk. In the first instance, you can complete the form only, stating the reason why you are appealing to Borden Grammar, together with your son's test scores. You should send further supporting evidence by Wednesday, 19th April. As soon as your form is received, an information pack will be sent to you with guidance on how to appeal

You have the right of a face-to-face appeal to present your case but if you prefer for it to be heard in your absence based on the information you provide then please let the school know as soon as possible.

Appeals lodged after the appeals deadline of 28th March will be heard within 30 days of submitting the request.

If you did not name Borden Grammar on your application to KCC, you should submit your appeal directly to us after Tuesday, 25th April 2023.

Appeals are scheduled to commence 21st April 2023. Decision letters will be sent after all appeals have been heard.
