Monday, 1st March 2021 the offer of a place will be given.

If you named Borden Grammar School as one of your preferences on the SCAF but have not been offered a place at the School, then you have a statutory right of appeal.

Provisional Dates

Appeals are scheduled to take place within 40 working days after the deadline for appeals on 26th March, precise dates to be confirmed. Appellants will be notified in writing of the date of their appeal at least 10 days prior to their hearing (unless they have agreed to waive this right). If an appellant fails to attend or is unable to attend and it is impractical to offer an alternative date, the appeal will go ahead and be decided on the written evidence supplied by them.

Please note face-to-face appeals may change depending on Government Advice at the time. If face-to-face meetings are not possible the appeals will be conducted as a paper exercise on the written evidence provided.

Appeals lodged after the appeals deadline of 26th March and other appeals known as 'In-Year Casual Admission' appeals will be heard within 30 days of submitting the request.
