



Borden Grammar School Sixth Form Dress Code



Students should be aware that the interpretation of this code is the responsibility of the school. Any decisions made on individual items of wear or aspects of appearance will be binding.

All Students

- The basic principle of what a student may wear will be centred upon the idea of 'office wear'. Clothes and overall appearance should reflect accepted good practice by young, professional employees.
- Hair styles and any other items should reflect this principle.
- All clothes should be neat, clean and tidy

Boys

- Suit or jacket and trousers (denim & coloured jeans are not permitted)
- Jackets preferred at all times but must be worn at formal occasions
- Shirt and tie
- Shoes (brown or black)
- If ears are pierced a discreet stud should be worn during school hours/stretchers should either be removed during school or replaced with a 'flesh coloured plug'.

Girls

- Shirt, blouse and/or tops with long or short sleeves (T shirts/vest tops are not permitted)
- Tailored trousers/shorts or skirt or a dress (Denim/leggings/combat trousers are not permitted)
- A suit may be worn in place of the above
- Shoes or sandals should be flat or low heeled (Worker boots/uggs are not acceptable)
- Jewellery (including earrings) should be discreet and kept to a minimum/ stretchers should either be removed during school or replaced with a 'flesh coloured plug'.
- Hair styles should reflect the basic principle under 'All Students'.
